

FOREST THINNING UNDERWAY

During the winter of 2021, work will be underway for a stand release project on 5 acres at the Lyre Conservation Area. The conifers that were planted after logging events in 2013 are competing for light, water and nutrients with salmonberry, red alder, and other native vegetation. These stands are too dense to support a healthy forest at this time. Thinning will allow adequate growing room for the conifers and alders to be retained and will foster optimal forest health.
